

## **ADVERTISEMENT TO RECRUIT ENUMERATORS**

The Department of Food Science and Technology needs to recruit four (4) enumerators to administer questionnaires for the SASSCAL Task 335 project entitled “*Cultivation, value addition and marketing of climate smart emerging crops to improve food security in Botswana*” (TASK ID 335) in Kweneng District (Letlhakeng/Molepolole). The objective of the survey is to assess the market potential and marketing prospects for indigenous emerging crops, namely, morama (*Tylosema esculentum*) and kgengwe (*Citrullus lunatas*) and to determine consumers’ willingness to pay for products processed from these indigenous resources.

A total of 300 questionnaires will be administered and shared equally between 4 enumerators. Each enumerator will be required to administer 75 questionnaires in a total of five days.

### **Requirements**

- BSc graduates in Agricultural Economics, Food Science and Technology or related fields are preferred.
- Previous experience as a survey enumerator will be an advantage.

### **Remuneration**

- BWP 25:00 will be paid per completed questionnaire
- The enumerators will also be provided with transport to the research sites and subsistence allowance at BUAN rates @ P192.70 per night to cover accommodation and meals for 5 nights
